

Female school leaders from schools across the world, at any stage of their career – aspiring, early stage or experienced – who have a passion for international education and are seeking to develop themselves and their schools to think and act more globally.

Through your participation in this course, you will:

- acquire the tools you need to audit and develop your school's international strategies
- meet and build a network with school leaders from schools across the world
- grow in personal effectiveness as a strong female leader.

We have chosen as our venue the international and community-focused Traidhos Centre, 25km outside Chiang Mai, Thailand. The venue itself is designed to prompt intense personal reflection, and as part of the course we will visit a local educational project which will engage the participants in a deep understanding of the purpose of education in a global world.

Internationalisation is a pressing need in schools and there is a strong business case for you to attend. A core tenet of this course is also that by developing strong female school leaders, schools and their communities across the world will flourish.

This innovative and inspirational course can transform both you and your school.

WHAT DOES THE 5 DAY COURSE INVOLVE?

Led by two highly experienced former school principals from the UK and Australia, with significant international experience, this course will challenge you to reflect and to develop practical strategies to lead your school's internationalisation policy.

Beginning with a welcome meal on Day 1, the course will involve a mixture of venue-based experiential workshops and fieldwork in the nearby community. A focus on personal and professional transformation runs through the 5 days, aiming to strengthen each participant's capacity to lead her school's global strategy.

The three key pillars of this practical course are:

- opening our eyes to global possibilities and relationships
- recognising and developing the power of personal leadership
- action planning for change in our schools

Each participant will benefit from one-to-one Skype coaching ahead of the course, and in the months following the course. Participants are also expected to commit to build on the relationships that they forged during the course, to enable their schools to benefit from the networks that they have established.

WHAT IS INCLUDED?

- 3 hours in total of one-to-one coaching via Skype, prior to and after the course
- Course facilitation, field trips and other activities, including daily mindfulness, cultural activities and an afternoon of guided sightseeing.
- All meals, accommodation (in single ensuite rooms) and course materials over the 5 day course in Chiang Mai, from the evening of Day 1 to lunch on Day 5.
- Transfers between Chiang Mai airport and the Traidhos Community on Day 1 and Day 5 of the course.

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED?

- Flights to/from Chiang Mai
- Travel insurance
- Visas if required
